
Information Technology Services will interview returning student employees to garner interest in placement within the **TECH** *Academy*.

Incoming freshman are encouraged to apply for **TECH** *Academy* during their senior year in high school. First-year students may apply to the Academy prior to the start of each semester.


First-year students will start their career track working at the IT Service Desk and progress through to Field Services in their second year. Learn more at www.ysu.edu/techacademy.

At the end of their second year, students will select an "IT specialty" – to which IT Services will try to match with business needs for placement. Qualified

> candidates will then be assigned a senior level staff member (i.e. Architect/Engineer) as a "mentor" for the next two years.

TECH *Academy* mentors will provide specialized training in Cybersecurity, Networking, Server/Cloud configuration, Application Services, Technology Training and CyberLearning. Progress assessments will be provided each semester.

Career goals will be set each semester with the intent of preparing students to become a full-time Technician 1 or Analyst 1 in their senior year, or upon graduation.
