### Additional Information

- **Students should work closely with advisors at both institutions to discuss options.**
- **This Agreement centers around the principle that YSU students can acquire a baccalaureate degree from YSU by applying the first year of professional law courses at Akron Law to satisfy the graduation and degree requirements at YSU, and also concurrently apply the first year of Akron Law courses (28 semester credit hours) toward a juris doctor degree granted by The University of Akron.**

- **YSU students participating in the joint 3+3 program who have completed the equivalent of three years or more of a baccalaureate degree will be automatically admitted into Akron Law so as long they are in good standing academically, financially, and from a disciplinary perspective at YSU; satisfy the standards required of all students admitted to Akron Law; score at least 150 on the LSAT examination; and have an undergraduate grade point average of at least 3.40 by the mid-point of their junior year.**

**All students must meet or complete:**

- 1. All residency requirements- 30 credits and 16 upper division for YSU, plus major and minor residency.**
- 2. For purposes of admission to law school, Participants will need to submit to Akron Law only their YSU transcripts, LSAT score, and a standard application within the established time parameters for admission.**
