- Foundation social work content is comprised of eight courses and two field practicums with an emphasis on the following areas: Human Behavior in the Social Environment, Oppressed Populations and Cultural Competency, Social Work Foundation Practice, Advanced Treatment Planning and Outcomes, Social Work and the DSM, Substance Use and Treatment
- The foundation field education is designed to provide the student with learning experiences that promote and integrate the achievement of foundation objectives.
- The foundation field practicum is taken in two consecutive semesters for a total of six credit hours.

- **The advanced standing MSW program can be completed in one, two, three, or four years.**
