

## Teacher Education Program Prerequisites

Primary/Primary Intervention Specialist (ELIS), Middle Childhood (MCE) Adolescent/Young Adult (AYA) and AYA/Special Education applications are submitted by

- ▶ September 15 (see respective program area for when to apply)
- ▶ January 30 (see respective program area for when to apply)

Applications submitted after the deadline are NOT guaranteed acceptance in time to register for respective coursework.

### Upper Division Requirements:

- Minimum completion of 50 semester hours
- Minimum overall GPA of 2.75
- ENGL 1550 and 1515 “B” average or better  
If failure to meet B average, need ENGL 2601 with “B” or better. If “C” or below in ENGL 2601, retake the course to achieve “B” average.
- EDFN 1501, CMST 1545, SPED 2630, & one designated concentration area course (as listed on the back of your curriculum sheet)
- Writing Assessment
- Blackboard Module – OAE Assessment
- Pre-Service Teacher Permit

- ▶ Apply one year in advance of **SECOND** preclinical
- Upper division status, minimum overall GPA 2.75

- ▶ FALL ONLY – apply one year in advance
- Upper division status, minimum overall GPA 2.75

- Completion of content courses in one (1) area
- Average of 2.67 GPA in each content area coursework
- ATTEMPT OAE Foundations of Reading (190)
- CURRENT Pre-Service Teacher Permit

### AYA/SPED Preclinical:

- ▶ FALL ONLY – apply one year in advance
- Upper division status, minimum overall GPA 2.75
- SPED 2630
- TERG 2605
- SPED 4867
- SED 3706
- Average of 2.67 GPA in content area coursework
- ATTEMPT OAE Foundation of Reading (190)
- CURRENT Pre-Service Teacher Permit

### AYA Preclinical:

- ▶ FALL ONLY – apply one year in advance
- Upper division status, minimum overall GPA 2.75
- SPED 2630
- TERG 3711
- SED 3706
- Completion prescribed program prerequisites
- Average of 2.67 GPA in content area coursework
- CURRENT Pre-Service Teacher Permit

### Student Teaching:

- ▶ Apply semester prior to intended student teaching semester
- Upper division and senior status
- A minimum overall GPA 2.75
- Completion of program prerequisites
- An average of 2.67 GPA in major/teaching area and professional education courses (each computed separately with no grade less than a “C”)
- Passage of respective OAE content test(s)
- CURRENT Pre-Service Teacher Permit

No other courses may be taken with student teaching except as stipulated in the specific program requirements. The Director of Advising must be notified in writing prior to a student’s attempt to register for course(s) outside of student teaching.

*Candidates will not be permitted to take the following professional education courses more than twice: EDFN 1501, EDFN 3708, PSYC 3709, SPED 2630, TERG 2605, TERG 3700, TERG 3720, TERG 3730, TERG 3711, TEMC 3702, SED 4800 series, ELIS 2601, ELIS 3700, pre-student teaching courses – ELIS Preclinical, MCE Preclinical, SPED Preclinical, AYA Preclinical, student teaching seminar, and student teaching.*
